American Red Cross Advanced Life Support (ALS) Course

Starting December 11, 2019

COURSE OVERVIEW

The American Red Cross Advanced Life Support (ALS) Course provides participants with the knowledge and skills they need to assess, recognize and care for patients who are experiencing a respiratory emergency, shock or a cardiac emergency. The course emphasizes providing high-quality patient care by integrating psychomotor skills, rhythm interpretation, electrical interventions and pharmacologic knowledge with critical thinking and problem solving to achieve the best possible outcomes.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

1. Demonstrate high-quality basic life support (BLS) skills, including high-quality chest compressions, effective ventilations and use of an AED.
2. Apply concepts of effective teamwork when caring for a patient experiencing a cardiovascular, cerebrovascular or respiratory emergency.
3. Integrate advanced communication, critical-thinking and problem-solving skills when responding as part of a team to a cardiovascular, cerebrovascular or respiratory emergency.
4. Apply a systematic, continuous approach to assess, recognize and care for an adult experiencing a cardiovascular, cerebrovascular or respiratory emergency.
5. Effectively assess, recognize and care for an adult experiencing respiratory or cardiac arrest.
6. Quickly recognize the nature of a cardiovascular, cerebrovascular or respiratory emergency.
7. Provide effective and appropriate advanced life support care to address a cardiovascular, cerebrovascular or respiratory emergency.
8. Provide effective and appropriate care after a return of spontaneous circulation (ROSC) during a resuscitation effort.
