IN SUPPORT OF DHA'S MISSION

The Defense Health Agency's Implementation Science Program (ISP) is a support function within the Research and Engineering (R&E) Directorate. R&E ISP supports the DHA mission by transitioning mature, priority, evidence-based medical research and innovations into practice to optimize its impact.

On average, it takes **17** years for only **14**% of clinical research to translate into practice.^{1,2}

R&E ISP equips the DHA with standardized strategies and tools to enhance readiness, patient and staff experiences, and health outcomes.

Implementation science (IS) leading practices help implementers reduce the time lag from research discovery to clinical implementation.³

Results from the Field: R&E ISP Project Partnerships

R&E ISP partners with clinical subject matter experts to execute projects aligned with DHA priorities, such as provision of exceptional care, early detection and mitigation of disease impact, and reduction of duty limiting conditions.



My Military Health: Primary Care & Behavioral Health

Established a repeatable implementation system to transition innovations from the Accelerating Care Transformation's (ACT) Venture sites to spread and scale across the enterprise.



Hospital Readmission Prevention

Developed a comprehensive dissemination and implementation campaign to increase clinical staff awareness and use of interventions to prevent hospital readmissions.



Direct Access to Physical Therapy (DAPT) Pilot

Standardized appointing to allow Service members to receive physical therapy for acute injuries without a referral, reducing wait times and improving readiness.



Trauma Research Translation

Developed a framework to deconstruct clinical practice guidelines (CPGs) into 15 categories that convey clear trauma care guidance; weekly CPG downloads increased 4x during campaign.
