2026 MAY CCSS S03: Shaping Tomorrow's Force: Addressing Pediatric Obesity Today (1.0 clock hour)

Course Description: This session examines rising obesity trends in pediatric and active-duty populations and their direct impact on long-term military readiness. Participants will identify critical gaps in early diagnosis and apply evidence-based, family-centered counseling strategies rooted in lifestyle medicine to improve weight management outcomes. By bridging clinical recognition with actionable interventions, this session equips providers to better support military families and future service members.

1. Describe current trends in pediatric and active-duty obesity and explain their implications for future military readiness.
2. Identify gaps in early recognition and diagnosis of pediatric obesity, including delays highlighted in recent research and clinical practice.
3. Apply evidence-based, family-centered counseling strategies—including lifestyle medicine principles—to improve nutrition and weight management in pediatric populations within military settings.
