2. Explain how treating depressive disorders with Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation can help patients achieve full rehabilitation potential after mild traumatic brain injury.
3. Describe the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved biomarkers and medical devices that aid in evaluating and managing traumatic brain injury, including limitations and specific considerations for the military population.
4. Evaluate the clinical utility of Microstructure Anatomy Gradient for Neuroimaging with Ultrafast Scanning (MAGNUS) in detecting mild traumatic brain injury and its potential to inform return to duty decisions, advance research on neural biomarkers, sleep health, and cognitive performance.
